Mr. Poole has scheduled more meetings for the committee and will give an update at the mid year board meeting. A position paper on Backflow prevention assemblies for irrigation sprinkler systems was passed, and an Electronic Meeting Policy was passed. A name change for the newsletter committee was passed it will now be called the magazine committee, the membership committee was given some guidance as to what the board would like to see added for membership a new corporate rate and perhaps an associate membership. A request to establish a Scholarship Committee was passed and a proposal for a policy and position paper on water fed back up sump pump was passed. The Budget for the associations 2006/2007 year was passed, this years budget includes a \$30,000 contingency budget which we have not been able to do in the past. This years budget is \$470,195.00 and should fund all the committees working on ABPA functions. The 2007 International Conference and Trade Show will be held in Reno Nevada on April 29 thru May 2<sup>nd</sup> so mark your calender, also if you would like to work on a National Committee they usually meet starting the week before the Conference. More information on these meetings will be on the ABPA web site prior to the meetings.

The Western Regional Conference will be held this year in Las Vegas, Nevada on October 9,10,11 at the Orleans Hotel. The mid year National ABPA Board meeting will be held Sunday Oct 8 at the Orleans Hotel, please mark your calenders this Regional Conference covers topics that relate to our region and gives you a chance to network with fellow ABPA members in your region. I will be asking chapter presidents to help support this regional effort.

Also it is time to start thinking about your next Region 7 Director, it has been an honor to serve as Regional Director but is time to get to the next phase of my life (retirement) so please give some thought who you would like to see as your next Director, it is important that we have a voice in the National Association direction.
